This product is available without a doctor's prescription, for your use as a food supplement. Nevertheless you still need to use **Matrivir** carefully to get the best results from it.

- You must see a doctor if you experience troubling symptoms.

WHAT MATRIVIR IS USED FOR:

A Multi-vitamin and mineral supplement for women planning pregnancy, during pregnancy, and while breastfeeding.

Expecting a baby is one of the most joyful experiences in your life. However, this is also a time of great change and challenges, in particular for your body, because it is housing and developing another life. For this crucial period in life it is very important to supply your body with the most balanced and complete essential nutrients. Congratulations on making a good choice, by selecting **Matrivir** to start this period in a nutritionally balanced and complete way.

During pregnancy your nutritional requirements change significantly and it is essential to have a balanced nutrient intake. This cannot be achieved by just increasing the quantity of food-intake, but by a healthier, balanced diet which includes nutrient rich foods such as fruits, vegetables, whole grains, lean meat, poultry and low fat dairy products.

The supplementation of your healthy diet with a prenatal multivitamin – while planning pregnancy, during pregnancy and while breastfeeding – offers many benefits for mother and baby.

Matrivir offers the complete range of vitamins, minerals and trace elements, micronutrients needed for the normal development of the baby, together with ensuring the well-being and health of the mother. **Matrivir**, with its complete set of vitamins, minerals and trace elements, delivers all these nutrient components to you:

Folic Acid is indispensable for cell production and normal growth of the foetus during pregnancy, and it is recommended for the prevention of neural tube and other birth defects. Research has shown that consuming 200 mcg folic acid, plus additional food folate from food intake, can reduce the risk of neural tube defects by 50 - 70%. Consuming adequate amounts of folic acid (200 mcg folic), ensures the normal development of the foetal spinal cord.

Iodine During pregnancy, increased levels of iodine are recommended. Iodine, which is part of the thyroid hormones, is important for the normal development and metabolic processes of your child.

Iron (Ferum) is a mineral necessary for the pregnant women and embryo. It ensures the delivery of oxygen to the increased amount of blood in the body during pregnancy and the maintenance of normal level of haemoglobin. Enough quantity of iron supports the healthy growing of the embryo and the strong bone system of the baby.

Calcium is used during pregnancy and lactation for bone and teeth development, breast milk production and for maternal calcium stores.

Zinc is important for normal cell division and DNA synthesis, and is especially important for the development of the baby's immune system.

Vitamins (e.g. folic acid, vitamins A, B, C, D and E) are indispensable compounds, which act as regulators for the entire metabolic process, and are necessary for the proper function of the body.

Minerals (e.g. magnesium and calcium) **and trace elements** (e.g. iodine, copper, selenium, chromium, molybdenum, iron and zinc) fulfill important tasks in the body as construction elements and regulator substances in the bones and connective tissues. They also function as activators or components of enzymes, hormones and red blood cells.

Micronutrients The body needs micronutrients (vitamins, minerals and trace elements) on a daily basis. This is especially important during pregnancy (planning, during, and after). It is therefore recommended to maintain a regular supply during pregnancy and while breastfeeding your baby. The intake of just one multivitamin tablet per day helps provide the vitamins, minerals and trace elements you need when planning pregnancy, during pregnancy and during the breastfeeding period.

BEFORE YOU TAKE MATRIVIR:

Do not take Matrivr if you are allergic to any of the excipients.

Take special care with MATRIVIR:

- Do not exceed the recommended daily dose/amount.
- If you are taking other supplements, read the label, since supplements may contain the same ingredient.
- Product contains iron, which can be harmful to children if taken in large doses. In case of accidental overdose, contact your doctor or poison control centre immediately.

Pregnancy and Breastfeeding

MATRIVIR is scientifically formulated for pregnant and breastfeeding women and women planning pregnancy.

HOW TO USE MATRIVIR:

Recommended for women planning pregnancy, during pregnancy, and while breastfeeding. Take 2 capsules daily, or as directed by a physician.

The recommended daily dose should not be exceeded.

A varied and balanced diet and a healthy lifestyle are important, and this product should not be used as a substitute for a balanced diet.

If more MATRIVIR has been used than recommended:

In case of accidental overdose, discontinue use and seek professional assistance immediately.

The following signs and symptoms may be associated with an overdose of Matrivr.

Gastrointestinal disorders:

Diarrhoea

Metabolism and nutrition disorders:

Hyper-vitaminosis D

POSSIBLE SIDE-EFFECTS:

The following side effects may be associated with the use of Matrivr and are listed under their corresponding body system organ class:

Immune system disorders:

Hypersensitivity

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS:

Store at or below 25°C in a cool, dry place.
